UNIQUE, EMOTIONAL, FASCINATING & UNFORGETTABLE

Discover the award winning World Heritage listed Port Arthur Historic Site to connect with Australia's convict past, and the history, that has helped shaped the nation. For more than forty years until its closure in 1877, Port Arthur was a secondary punishment station and was a military and industrial centre, encompassing mining, farming, timber cutting, boat building and many other trades.

Visitors can meet the rogues and the righteous, villains and victors, saints and lost souls of Port Arthur through a variety of interpretive experiences, including guided tours, harbour cruise, multimedia presentations, restored houses, museum displays, as well as a high-tech audio installation at the dockyard.

The redeveloped visitor centre showcases the state-of-the-art Port Arthur Gallery, introducing 52 new character stories for visitors to engage with history, connect with the people of Port Arthur and view rare collection items.

The Port Arthur Historic Site offers different dining options allowing visitors to choose from casual café alfresco dining to à la carte restaurant service in 1830 Restaurant and Bar offering stunning sweeping views of the historic site.

Not to be missed are the magnificent Gardens, convict ruins and historic buildings and short walking trails through the natural bush surrounding Port Arthur.

As there is a lot to see and do at Port Arthur, site entry passes are valid for two consecutive days, and includes a self guided Port Arthur audio experience, entry to the Port Arthur Gallery, a 20 minute harbour cruise, complimentary site talks at various locations throughout the day and access to more than 30 historic buildings, ruins, heritage gardens and walking trails.

Additional paid experiences include the Convict Tour, Isle of the Dead Cemetery Tour, Escape from Port Arthur Tour.

For those brave enough, the ever popular Ghost Tours begin after dark.

- Port Arthur Historic Site is one of the Cultural Attractions of Australia and 1 of the 11 sites that form the Australian Convict Sites World Heritage Property
- Site Entry ticket includes a self guided audio experience, harbour cruise and entry for two consecutive days

- Port Arthur Historic Site is open 7 days (except Christmas Day) guided tours available between 9am–5pm
- 1830 Restaurant & Bar open for dinner from Wednesday–Saturday from 5pm
- Port Arthur is the starting point for those embarking on the Three Capes Track Port Arthur is located just 60 minutes from the airport (you'll need to make your own way to us, transport is not included)

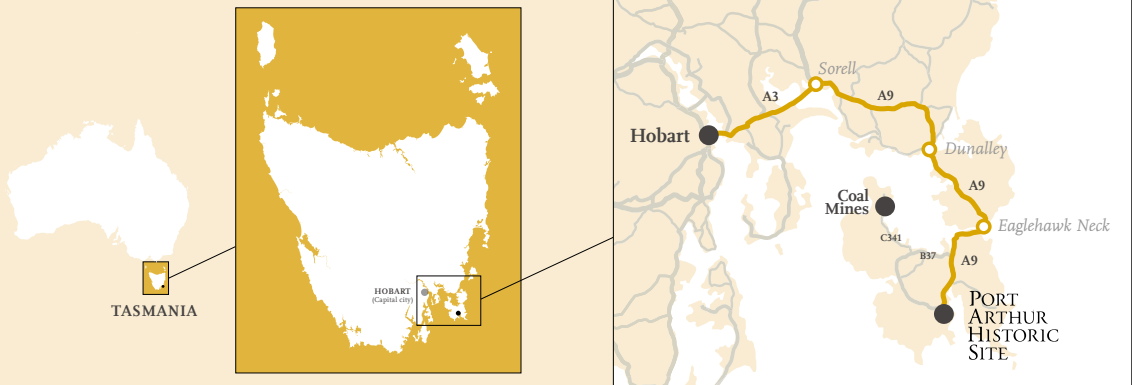

ADDITIONAL TOURS

Convict Tour

The 45 minute guided Convict tour provides a general overview of the history of Port Arthur and its significance as a secondary punishment station. The tour is accessible with minimal walking.

Isle of the Dead Cemetery Tour

The Isle of the Dead holds the stories of many of the people of Port Arthur.

On this 40 minute tour, journey to the island aboard the MV Marana, and take a guided walking tour of the island.

Ghost Tour

As the sun sets, come out to the dark grounds of the Port Arthur Historic Site for a 90 minute, lantern-lit Ghost Tour.

Commandant's Tour

Enjoy exclusive access to Port Arthur Historic Site much like the Commandant and his guests.

This 90-minute guided tour explores some of the site's most significant buildings, including the Penitentiary, the Separate Prison, and the Convict Church.

Tour the site and the buildings, with an expert guide offering fascinating insights into the people and characters who lived, worked, and served their time at Port Arthur.

Escape from Port Arthur Tour

Port Arthur was the perfect place for a prison – it was remote and isolated by both the foreboding natural landscape and deep tempestuous seas.

Despite the perilous odds, escape attempts were frequent and took many forms.

On this 60 minute guided walking tour meet cunning and criminal characters who went to extreme measures to escape from the Prison.

Wheel of Fate

Join an exclusive behind the scenes tour, exploring the 'wheel of fate' of some of Port Arthur's most notable individuals, see where they worked, slept and ate.

This experience allows exclusive expert access to Port Arthur's unique buildings, get behind the ropes to explore 19th century life in this infamous prison settlement, sample the Peninsula's amazing produce prepared by our in-house chef, served in the magnificent Visiting Magistrates House in this World Heritage Listed Site.
